### Involvement description for third sector board member

<b>Appointment:</b>	<b>Third Sector Representative Member</b> , North Wales Regional Partnership Board
<b>Accountable to:</b>	North Wales Regional Partnership Board
<b>Working with:</b>	Board Members, local Third Sector Networks, individual and carer groups, statutory partners.
<b>Reimbursement</b>	Voluntary basis
<b>Appointment term</b>	2 years
<b>Time commitment</b>	There could be up to 12 meetings per year (development sessions/board meetings)

### Role of the local North Wales Regional Partnership Board

The North Wales Regional Partnership Board provides leadership in decision making, guidance, influence and support to ensure successful delivery of Health and Care Services to people in North Wales.

### Role of the Third Sector Regional Partnership Board Member

Membership of the North Wales Regional Partnership Board provides a voice for a Third Sector provider of services with local and national remit. The additional Third Sector member chosen to represent service providers (the North Wales VSC's already have one place on the Board given its remit as the umbrella Third Sector partner operating in North Wales) will be recruited and appointed through completing an Expression of Interest form. Once the deadline has passed, provided the person specification is completely filled in and meets the general requirements for membership, people will be invited to attend a peer selection meeting for a half day of discussion/selection. Everyone will have a chance to meet each other, discuss the role and the requirements and choose a representative service provider who will represent them/the Sector on the North Wales Regional Partnership Board. These people will be encouraged to attend other Third Sector engagement forums, as listed in the attached information/governance structure.

The selection process for Third Sector members participating on the North Wales Regional Partnership Board needs to ensure the organisation selected represents a national perspective or experience, diversity, geography, understanding of a rural

service delivery model and also a wide spread of experience in delivering health and social care related services in North Wales/Nationally.

The organisation selected will be offered support to be fully functioning members of the Partnership. However, we would expect the organisation to have the skills necessary to ensure they are confident in understanding and digesting the documentation and information provided.
