This includes person centred community therapy services. Third sector partners will provide direct support to carers to assess their needs and to ensure that a network of support is made available. The health and social care workforces will be developed to ensure that high standards of care and support are implemented, with the use of assistive technology where appropriate. This scheme supports community development and engagement activities in line with the priorities within North Wales Dementia Strategy and the All Wales Dementia Standards.

D2RA Pathway 1 - Escalation of need in the Community & Admission Avoidance

Providing integrated services in a multi-disciplinary Community Resource Team. Directly supporting Discharge to Recover and Assess (D2RA) pathway 1 to provide assessments that avoid full hospital admission. Supporting people with clinical needs that can be managed in the community, enabling people to recover at home or close to home.

Introducing a new crisis management response team based within locality Multi-Disciplinary Teams (MDT) to support adults at risk, building on the findings of the Lightfoot consultancy review. MDT assessment to avoid full admission

Arrange treatment and support at home if clinically safe to do so

- Reducing ambulance call outs (WAST)
- Empowering individuals to take control of their care package
- Supporting Individuals to live independently
- Preventing hospital admissions
- Overnight falls prevention
- Necessary support for care package crisis / End of life

These projects include a wide range of approaches which will ensure safe and effective discharge planning. There will be a focus on achieving a safe transfer of care into the community and detailed assessments for long term care needs. increasing efficiency and expanding the workforce

and service capacity within the community. The provision of multidisciplinary reviews of the needs of high risk patients returning home to avoid a re-admission or further escalation of needs. Improvements in the use of data to enable increase intelligence and inform ongoing service priorities.
